Situated in the heart of Paris, the ENS is one of France's elite universities. The department of biology offers an exceptional multidisciplinary environment based on a broad range of biological research and multiple interactions with the departments of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.

The mission of the ENS is to train students for research through teaching linked with the surrounding research laboratories. The professor will teach genetics and molecular biology at undergraduate and graduate (master and doctorate) levels, in particular for the “Cell systems biology” programme coordinated by the biology department and for the doctoral training programme of the Pierre-Gilles de Gennes Foundation (http://www.fondation-pgg.org/index_uk.php)

The originality of the IBENS derives from the strong interactions between genetics and other biological fields. Within this pluridisciplinary context, ambitious projects dealing with the control of genome expression could be developed, whatever the biological model. Projects aimed at studying macromolecular machineries will be an asset.
