Jean-Charles CADIOU

Jean-Charles Cadiou is the executive president of CAPACITÉS, a structure created by the University of Nantes to enhance cooperations between laboratories and companies. CAPACITÉS works at all innovation levels, from the research stage to mature products. With a strong focus on technologies, CAPACITÉS works together with other structures such as the SATT Grand Ouest, specialized in the commercial approach. CAPACITÉS has an expertise over 9 economic sectors and employs currently 90 advisors.

Florent Vince is a project manager for WeAMEC (West Atlantic Marine Energy Center), a structure that gathers universities, research institutes and industrials in the west part of France. Florent Vince is in charge of European collaboration in marine renewable energy.

Sophie RENAUDIN

Sophie Renaudin is an advisor for the Office of Transfer of Technology and Industrial Partnerships (OTT&PI) within the APHP (Public Assistance – Paris Hospitals).
