Which mobility opportunities between France and Norway in the study fields of nursing, engineering & early childhood education?

The aim of these workshops is to explore possible ways to increase student mobility between France and Norway in professional education. **Three study fields will be investigated:** nursing, engineering and early childhood education. The following questions will be addressed: What are the main barriers to Franco-Norwegian mobilities in your study field? Which tools can be used to overcome these challenges?
